Conditions of Sale: Seller guarantees that this puppy is healthy to the best of her knowledge at the time of sale. Buyer has four days to take the puppy to the vet for a health exam, if any health concerns are found, the buyer may return puppy to the seller within one week with an explanation from the attending vet for a refund. No medical or travel charges will be refunded. During the first 72 hours the puppy should be isolated in a small area from any other pets and monitored for health, eating, eliminating and activity level. The puppy will need to be in a place where you can pet, handle, and give lots of love and attention. The buyer agrees to buy quality puppy food and provide adequate sanitary facilities. Buyer also agrees to provide adequate veterinary care and vaccinations. The seller is not responsible for any injury or illness caused by exposure to this puppy. Under no circumstances will this puppy be sold, leased or given away to any pet store, research laboratory, breeding mill or similar facility. This puppy will be kept indoors and not be allowed to roam freely outdoors as small dogs are frequently stolen, even from fenced yards. If the puppy dies within the first two years of life due to an inherited genetic disease, buyer must inform seller and provide a necropsy from a certified veterinarian. Seller will then replace the puppy when one becomes available.
